

1st Indo-Japan joint military exercise to start in Mizoram

GUWAHATI: In yet another step to deepen the strategic ties, India and Japan will hold the first ever joint military exercise from November 1. 'Dharma Guardian-2018' involving the Indian Army and Japan Ground Self Defence Force will go on till November 14 at the elite Counter Insurgency Warfare School, Vair-enge, in Mizoram, a defence spokesperson said. According to the defence spokesperson, the Indian contingent will be represented by 6/1 Gorkha Rifles while the Japanese contingent will be represented by the 32 Infantry Regiment.
