

Law panel for Aadhaar link with marriage

Approving a central amendment bill to make registration of marriages mandatory, the Law Commission sought it to be linked with Aadhaar to prevent fraudulent marriages and denial of subsistence to deserted women, reports **Dhananjay Mahapatra**.

In its report to law minister Ravi Shankar Prasad, the commission, headed by retired SC judge B S Chauhan, suggested a central portal for registration of births, marriages and deaths and said linking of Aadhaar would make “universal tracing of records” possible. **P 10**
