

FOUR MAOISTS ARRESTED IN DANTEWADA

RAIPUR: Four Maoists, including two women, were Saturday arrested in different places in Chhattisgarh's Dantewada district, police said. While three cadre were apprehended in a forest under Bhansi police station limits, another was held in Barsoor, Dantewada superintendent of police Abhishek Pallava said. Those arrested in Bhansi were identified as Meena Telam, 22, who was active as in-charge of "area supply team" of the Maoists, Manglo Telam, 25, a member of Mirtur local organisation squad and Bhima Kunjam, 25, a member of the Dandakaranya Adivasi Kisaan Majdoor Sangathan (a front outfit of Maoists), Pallava said. All three were associated with the Bhairamgarh "area committee" of the Maoists, he said.
