## 10\% GDP growth likely by Q4: Goyal

New Delhi, June 18
The Centre expects the GDP growth rate to be in double digits by the fourth quarter of the current fiscal year. It has also promised to keep the fiscal deficit within the budgeted target of 3.3 per cent despite 2019 being an election year.
Addressing a conference titled 'The Growth Net 6.0', organised by industry body CII here on Monday, interim Finance Minister Piyush Goyal said double-digit
growth was not impossible as the economy has been witnessing an uptick in demand. Moreover, the country offered a huge market for goods and services, he said.
"I think this government is taking efforts to make it easier to do honest business. And when this nation becomes a nation of honest business, 10 per cent plus growth is doable," he said.

GDP grew by 7.7 per cent in Q4 of FY18 while the growth rate for the entire fiscal
year was 6.7 per cent. Many agencies have predicted 7.3-7.75
