

## **India-Syria trade to reach \$500 m**

New Delhi, September 11

The bilateral trade between India and war-torn Syria is expected to reach \$500 million in the next three years as there are huge exports potential for domestic players in areas, including automobile, machinery and plastics, exporters body FIEO said Tuesday. Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) President Ganesh Kumar Gupta is leading an 84-member business delegation to Syria for discussing ways to promote trade. The bilateral trade between the countries stood at \$175 million in 2017 and it would reach \$500 million by 2020, he said in a statement. Gupta said India should review its exports strategy depending on imports profile of Syria. PTI
