

India, Morocco agree to boost defence ties

India and Morocco discussed the entire range of bilateral ties and agreed to enhance co-operation in the field of defence and security during talks between visiting Minister Delegate to the Head of Government in charge of the National Defence Administration, Morocco, Abdeltif Loudyi and Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman here on Tuesday.

The visiting dignitary is on a two-day official visit to India and this is the first ever visit by a Moroccan Defence Minister to India.

Giving details of the talks between the two Ministers, officials said the two sides identified fields of Hydrography, Peacekeeping, Telemedicine, Information Technology and Communications as well as Counter Terrorism and Counter Insurgency as potential areas for bilateral engagement.
