

Tribal museum to be set up in Guj

Vadodara: Gujarat chief minister Vijay Rupani said that his government will set up a tribal museum at a cost of ₹100 crore at Rajpipla town, about 75 kilometres from here, in the state's tribal-dominated Narmada district.

In his Independence Day speech in 2016, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had expressed a desire to have "permanent museums in the states where tribal freedom fighters lived". Mr Rupani made the announcement at a function at Nizar village in Tapi district in connection with the International Day of the World's Indigenous People. — PTI
