While Japan International Cooperation Agency is providing loan of 387.22 billion for the Western India project, the Eastern DFC (Mughalsarai-Allahabad-Kanpur-Khuria-

Dadri- & Khurja-Ludhiana) is being funded by the World Bank through a loan of \$2,360 billion.

The availability of this loan four years. Early this year, the railways had conducted a trial run on the Ateli-Phulera section of the Western DFC at a maximum speed of 100 km per hour. It took less than four hours to complete the journey.

According to its current road map, the railways is planning to commission both the lines by April 2020.

"There will be at least 10 feeder lines in the western corridor only connecting the main line to the supply freight. This is going to reduce the traffic by more than half in these busy routes," he said.

According to estimates, delay in the projects has led to a cost overrun of 189 per cent from the earlier lined up ₹281.81 billion in 2008 to ₹814.59 billion. This includes higher land costs.
