SATISFACTORY PROGRESS OF N.C.C.

State Representatives Conference.

New Delhi, May 5.- Satisfactory progress of the National Cadet Corps in all States was reported by States representatives who met in a conference in New Delhi today.

Mr.H.M.Patel, Secretary, Ministry of Defence, opened the conference with a brief address welcoming the States' representatives. Among those present were: Mr.B.B.Ghosh, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Defence, Major-General S.P.P.Thorat, Chief of General Staff, Army Headquarters, Air Vice-Marshal S.Mukherjee, Dy. C-in-C, IAF, and Capt.Samson of Naval Headquarters.

Progress reports were presented by the Director of the N.C.C., Col. Virendra Singh, and by the 13 State representatives for their respective States. The conference then discussed general and administrative matters relating to the Corps.
