PROMOTIONS IN THE INDIAN ARMY

Two vacancies in the rank of Lieutenant-General will occur when early in 1953 Lieutenant-General Rajendrasinhji becomes the Commander-in-Chief, Indian Army, and Lieutenant-General Nathu Singh retires on the expiry of his tenure as Army Commander.

In these two vacancies, the Government of India have decided to promote Major-General Sant Singh, and Major-General K.S.Thimayya.
