MAJ-GEN BIKRAM SINGH APPOINTED GOC DELHI AND RAJASTHAN AREA

MAJ-GEN U.C. DUBEY BECOMES GOC UP AREA

New Delhi, March 11, 1959.

Maj-Gen. Bikram Singh, lately General Officer Commanding, Assam, will succeed Maj-Gen. U.C. Dubey as GOC, Delhi and Rajasthan Area. He will formally take over charge on March 15, when Maj-Gen. Dubey will leave Delhi for Bareilly to take charge as GOC, U.P. Area.

Maj-Gen. Dubey, who has been GOC, Delhi and Rajasthan Area, since July 1955, is making a round of farewell visits to the various units under his command. Officers of Headquarters Delhi and Rajasthan Area, are giving a farewell dinner in his honour at the Vaughan Club, Delhi Cantonment, on Saturday, March 14, 1959.

In the last four years that he has been in Delhi, Maj-Gen. Dubey organised the annual Army Day and Republic Day parades and receptions and ceremonials connected with visits of foreign dignitaries to the capital. He was also responsible for the staging of the Western Command Torchlight Tattoo in 1958.

Maj-Gen. D.C. Misra has taken over as GOC Assam.
