INDONESIAN NAVAL CHIEF'S ONE-DAY VISIT TO DELHI

New Delhi, Bhadra 2, 1882 August 24, 1960

Rear-AdmiralR.E. Martadinata, the Indonesian Minister of the Navy and the Chief of the Naval Staff, accompanied by Mrs. Martadinata, arrived here this morning by air from Djakarta. The Admiral, who is on his way to the USSR, was received on arrival at the Palam airport by Vice-Admiral R.D. Katari, Chief of the Naval Staff and Commodore S.M. Nanda from Naval HQ. The Indonesian Ambassador, Mr. R.H. Abdul Kadir was also present at the airport.

Later in the morning, Rear-Admiral Martadinata called on the Defence Minister, Shri V.K. Krishna Menon, the Deputy Defence Minister, Shri K. Raghuramiah, Admiral Katari and the Defence Secretary, Shri O. Pulla Reddi.

The visiting Naval Chief was given a reception at INS INDIA, the Navy's shore establishment in the capital, and later entertained to lunch by Admiral Katari. Rear-Admiral Martadinata will leave Delhi by air tomorrow morning.
