INDIAN NAVY'S SUMMER EXERCISES COMMENCE

NEW DELHI, July 9, 1963.

The Indian Navy's annual summer training exercises commenced today with the departure of the Fleet from Bombay and Cochin.

Led by INS MYSORE, flying the flag of Rear Admiral A.K. Chatterji, Flag Officer Commanding the Indian Fleet, a number of naval ships are participating in these exercises. Similar exercises are held during spring and autumn every year.

The first phase of the exercises will be held in the Arabian Sea and the next in the Bay of Bengal and the Andaman Sea. Altogether, the exercises will last about seven weeks.

During the course of these exercises, the ships will, in different groups, pay goodwill visits to Malaya, Singapore and Thailand.
