GENERAL SUBRAMANIAN TO HEAD ARMED FORCES
MEDICAL SERVICES

Lieutenant General AR Subramanian will take over as Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services on June 1. He succeeds Lt Gen VVS Pratapa Rao, who retires on May 31 after 38 years of distinguished service.

Commissioned in December, 1948, Lt Gen Subramanian specialised in medicine. He has held various specialist and administrative appointments in the Armed Forces. He underwent a specialised training in Cardio-Pulmonary Diseases in 1970 in Australia on a fellowship under the Colombo Plan. He was elected Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (Edin) in 1976. In May 1982, he attended a conference on the Commonwealth Defence Science Organisation held in Australia.

General Subramanian is a post-graduate teacher and examiner of the Pune and other Universities in Medicine since 1965.
