ADMIRAL AUDITTO PROMOTED

Rear Admiral Arun Auditto, who has been elevated to Flag Rank, will take over as Assistant Chief of Naval Staff(Operations) on Saturday, June 25th.

Admiral Auditto was commissioned in 1955 and specialised in torpedo and anti-submarine warfare. He was among the first batch of Indian officers who was selected for service in the submarine arm.

Prior to the present assignment, he was the Director of the Submarine Arm and his commands at sea include a missile frigate squadron and a submarine squadron.

During the Goa operations of 1961, Admiral Auditto (then a Lieutenant) was severely wounded while successfully leading the sea-borne assault on Anjadeep Island. He was awarded the Nau Sena Medal.
