LT GEN PAUL APPOINTED DG ARMED FORCES MEDICAL SERVICES

Lt Gen Jaswant Singh Paul has taken over as Director General Armed Forces Medical Services here today.

An eminent physician, Lt Gen Jaswant Singh Paul is the senior most physician of the Armed Forces, having served as an Adviser and Senior Consultant in medicine. He was deputed as a Cardiologist to King of Bhutan from 1967 to 1969 and has been the President of Indian Society of Haematology. Currently he is a member of the Governing Body of Association of Physicians of India and since 1972 is a post graduate teacher for medicine of Delhi University.

Commissioned in 1952 in the Army Medical Corps, he served in different Field Medical Units in J & K, Assam and Nagaland. Later, he was Commandant of a Command Hospital and DDMS of an Area Headquarters. In the office of DGAFMS, he has held the appointments of Senior Consultant in Medicine and recently Addl DGAFMS.
