VICE ADMIRAL MB GHOSH NEW CHIEF OF MATERIALS

Vice Admiral MB Ghosh, assumed the office of Chief of Materials (COM) the apex appointment in the Materials Branch of our Navy today at the Naval Headquarters. The Materials branch manages the entire functioning of the materials organisation of the Navy including the 'logistids, fleet maintenance, naval architecture, dockyards, refit of ships, marine and electrical engineering systems, as well as quality and value-engineering aspects of marine technology.

A product of the National Defence Academy (NDA), Vice Admiral Mauli Bhushan Ghosh has the distinction of having headed both the Naval Dockyards - at Bombay as well as Visakhapatnam. He is a graduate of the Royal Naval Engineering College (RNEC), Plymouth where he specialised in Marine Engineering as also from the National Defence College (NDC), New Delhi, prior to holding several prestigious appointments such as Chief Staff Officer (Technical) at Western Naval Command Headquarters, Director of Marine Engineering and Director of Logistic Support. Besides a deputation at HAL, he has also been on deputation to Ethiopia. Prior to assuming office of COM, he was the Controller of Warship Production and Acquisition (CWP & A).

For his gallantry and distinguished services, the COM was decorated with Nao Sena Medal (NM) and later with Ati Vishisht Seva Medal (AVSM).
