VICE ADMIRAL INDERJIT BEDI IS NEW FOC-IN-C, SOUTHERN NAVAL
COMMAND

Vice Admiral Inderjit Bedi has taken over as Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief of Southern Naval Command, Cochin. Prior to this, he was Commandant, National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla.

Commissioned in the Indian Navy on 1st July 1958 Admiral Bedi received advance telecommunications training at the Royal Military College of Science (UK). He is also a graduate of Defence Services Staff College, Wellington and the Naval War College (USA). He also obtained M.Sc. (Defence Studies) from Madras University.

Admiral Bedi's important assignments both afloat and ashore include Fleet Communication Officer of the Western fleet during 1971 operations, Commanding Officer of the patrol vessel INS KAMORTA and the frigates INS Udaygiri and INS Godavari.

Admiral Bedi was Director of Naval Signals and Director of Personnel at Naval Hqrs. He was also Fortress Commander, Andaman & Nicobar islands, the only unified Command in India.

Admiral Bedi is also a Fellow of the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers, for his contribution in the field of Naval Communications.

Besides he was awarded Ati Vishisht Seva Medal in 1986 for his distinguished services.
