PS DAS, NEW FLAG OFFICER COMMANDING-IN-CHIEF
EASTERN NAVAL COMMAND

Vice Admiral PS Das took over as Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command on 31 May 95.

Graduate of Defence Services Staff College, Wellington India, Vice Admiral PS Das attended a course at Naval War College in USA. Amongst his major appointments, he has served afloat in several ships and his commands at Sea include those of the guided missile Corvette INS Vijaydurg and the guided missile destroyer INS Rajput.

As Chief of Staff, Eastern Naval Command, he was closely associated with the conduct of operations in Sri Lanka from 1987 to 1990. He commanded the Eastern fleet from January 1990 to September 1991 before moving to Naval HQ as Director General Project Sea Bird where he was responsible for the setting up of major Naval base at Karwar on the west coast. On his promotion to the rank of Vice Admiral in October 1992, Admiral Das held tri-service command as the Fortress Commander, Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Before moving to the present appointment, he was Director General Defence Planning Staff in the Ministry of Defence.

In recognition of his distinguished services he was awarded Vishist Seva Medal in 1978 and Uttam Yudh Seva Medal in 1989.
