Rice: About **10.05 lakh ha** area coverage under rice has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**7.56 lakh ha**). Thus **2.50 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Uttarakhand (1.22 lakh ha), Arunachal Pradesh (1.17 lakh ha), Nagaland (1.07 lakh ha), Meghalaya (0.97 lakh ha), Odisha (0.71 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.61 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.60 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.54 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.43 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.40 lakh ha), Mizoram (0.35 lakh ha), Kerala (0.33 lakh ha), Assam (0.31 lakh ha), Tripura (0.30 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.26 lakh ha), Telangana (0.19 lakh ha), J&K (0.16 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.16 lakh ha), Haryana (0.13 lakh ha), Sikkim (0.10 lakh ha) and Jharkhand (0.05 lakh ha).

Pulses: About **4.58 lakh ha** area coverage under pulses has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**5.22 lakh ha**). Thus **0.64 lakh ha less area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Karnataka (1.75 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.69 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.54 lakh ha), Telangana (0.48 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.43 lakh ha), Nagaland (0.12 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.11 lakh ha), Haryana (0.10 lakh ha), J&K (0.07 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.07 lakh ha), Tripura (0.05 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.05 lakh ha) Andhra Pradesh (0.04 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.04 lakh ha), Odisha (0.02 lakh ha), Meghalaya (0.01 lakh ha), Punjab (0.01 lakh ha) and West Bengal (0.01 lakh ha).

Coarse cereals: About **19.16 lakh ha** area coverage under coarse cereals has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**10.82 lakh ha**). Thus **8.34 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Rajasthan (4.69 lakh ha), Himachal Pradesh (2.82 lakh ha), Karnataka (2.28 lakh ha), Haryana (1.76 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (1.68 lakh ha), J&K (1.60 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (1.26 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.72 lakh ha), Punjab (0.56 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.38 lakh ha), Telangana (0.20 lakh ha), Assam (0.16 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.08 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.06 lakh ha), Odisha (0.06 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.06 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.05 lakh ha) and Chhattisgarh (0.01 lakh ha).

Oilseeds: About **14.36 lakh ha** area coverage under oilseeds has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**7.01 lakh ha**). Thus **7.36 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Gujarat (6.73 lakh ha), Rajasthan (2.58 lakh ha), Maharashtra (2.14 lakh ha), Karnataka (1.19 lakh ha), Madhra Pradesh (0.59 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.31 lakh ha), Telangana (0.27 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.11 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.10 lakh ha), Odisha (0.06 lakh ha), Haryana (0.04 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.04 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.02 lakh ha) and J&K (0.02 lakh ha).

Sugarcane: About **48.63 lakh ha** area coverage under sugarcane has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**47.65 lakh ha**). Thus **0.98 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Uttar Pradesh (22.98 lakh ha), Maharashtra (9.28 lakh ha), Karnataka (4.17 lakh ha), Bihar (2.48 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (1.71 lakh ha), Gujarat (1.51 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (1.20 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (1.12 lakh ha), Haryana (0.94 lakh ha), Punjab (0.94 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.92 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.31 lakh ha), Telangana (0.30 lakh ha), Odisha (0.17 lakh ha) and West Bengal (0.16 lakh ha).

Jute & Mesta: About **5.78 lakh ha** area coverage under Jute & Mesta has been reported against the normal of corresponding week (**6.66 lakh ha**). Thus **0.87 lakh ha less area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of West Bengal (4.19 lakh ha), Bihar (0.85 lakh ha), Assam (0.57 lakh ha), Meghalaya (0.11 lakh ha), Odisha (0.04 lakh ha), Nagaland (0.01 lakh ha) and Tripura (0.01 lakh ha).

Cotton: About **28.77 lakh ha** area coverage under cotton has been reported against the normal of corresponding week (**23.50 lakh ha**). Thus **5.27 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Haryana (7.15 lakh ha), Gujarat (6.05 lakh ha), Rajasthan (5.45 lakh ha), Punjab (5.01 lakh ha), Telangana (4.23 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.70 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.08 lakh ha), Odisha (0.06 lakh ha) and Tamil Nadu (0.05 lakh ha).
